Public Questions

- State of trees on Old Road

Could I put on the agenda a question about the condition of the old trees on Old Road (beyond Throstle Nest Cottage). We've lost two in the past couple of years and both were clearly almost fully rotted away before they finally fell over. I love those trees and would really hate to see them go, but I think a tree expert should have a look at them to make sure the remaining ones are safe.

- Proposed Village Hall Extension

I understand The Village Hall Committee are proposing to spend approximately £30,000 of their own money plus a further similar sum of grant funding on building a temporary extension to the hall and in the process almost doubling the size of the hall.

As the hall is currently under used could the committee explain their reasoning behind this project and would the money not be better spent extending the kitchen and storage area down stairs.

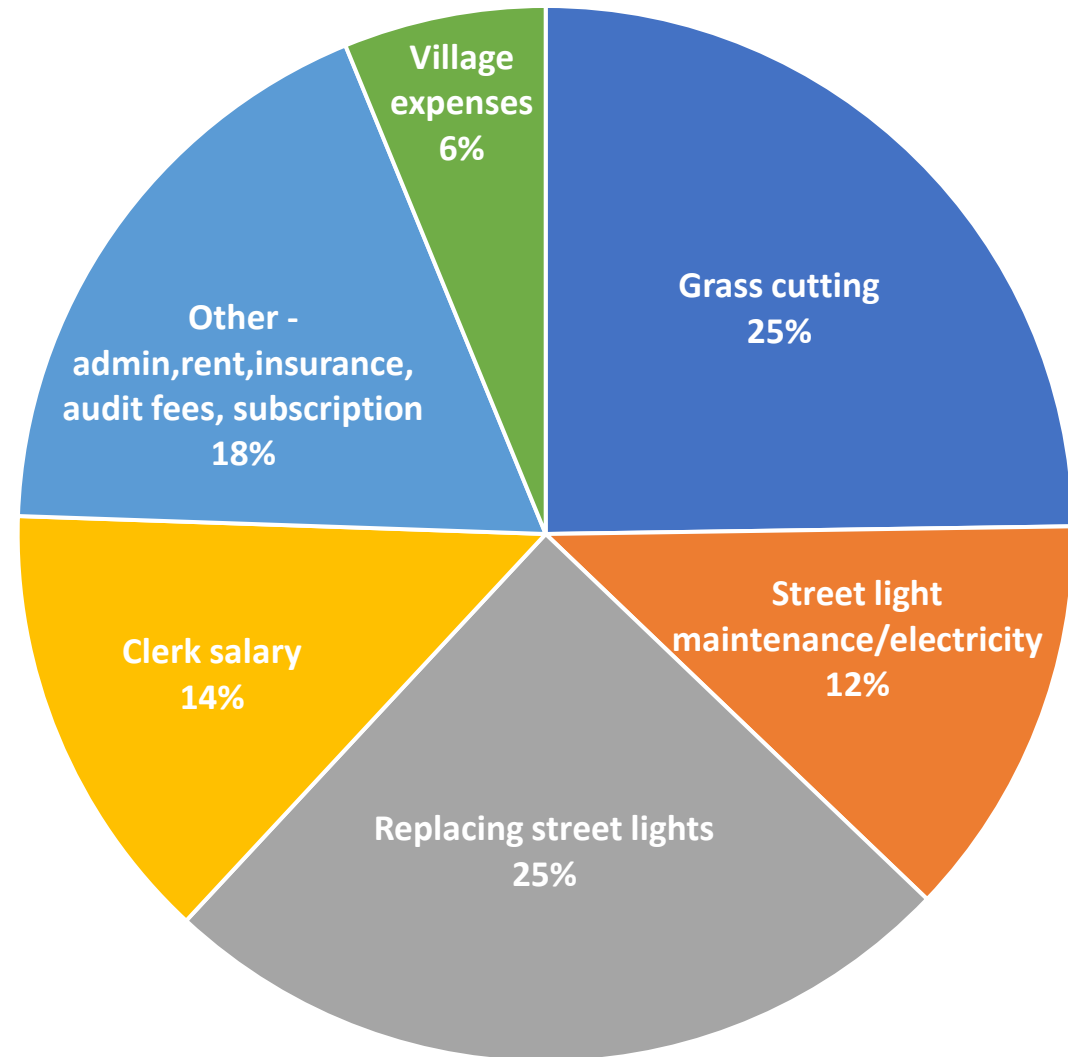
Finances
